The ACI - Rocky Mountain Chapter Graduate Scholarship is one \$1500 grant offered to Engineering students who show an interest in furthering the Research and Development of Concrete as a construction medium.

Eligibility requirements:

1. Any currently enrolled engineering student in Colorado and Wyoming who will be registered as a graduate in their respective specialty.
2. Must be Student Member of the Rocky Mountain Chapter of ACI. Membership is free and application can be completed online prior to submitting Scholarship Application. See page 3 for details.
3. The Scholarship may be awarded only to those students who will use it to continue their official graduate education at an ABET accredited educational establishment.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form. Download a PDF version of the application to be filled out.
- Personal essay which shall be no less than 1000 words and no more than 1500 words. The essay shall highlight, "How the scholarship will be used toward my concrete research."
- One letter of recommendation from any faculty member or Concrete Professional
- One sealed official transcript for any University attended in the last 4 years
- Resume
